### Important Tuition Facts...

- Tuition is billed on a monthly basis and due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month. Payments received after the 15<sup>th</sup> will be considered late and assessed a \$25.00 late fee. Children will not be permitted to return to preschool until the account is paid in full.
- 2. The registration fee covers:
  - All Snacks
  - -Art materials
  - -Curriculum materials
  - -Writing utensils
  - -Monthly subscriptions to My Big World, Science Spin, and Let's Find Out children's educational magazines
- Returned checks due to insufficient funds, etc. will be assessed a \$25.00 fee. Replacement payment must be made in cash or by money order only.
- 4. After your child has been enrolled for at least three months, you will be allowed one week vacation time for which you are not required to pay. This must be taken all in one week. A vacation request form must be completed in advance.
- 5. No money will be refunded for days missed due to illness.
- 6. All holidays and in service days will be factored into the tuition.

- 7. A discount of 20% will be given to siblings that are attending during the same year. Siblings who are attending Life Center Academy are also entitled to a discount that will be determine through the business office. A 5% discount for military, ministers, missionaries, Life Center Academy Graduates and Fountain of Life Center members.
- 8. On occasion, if child care is needed for additional days above what you have prepaid, the following fees apply:

Half Day - \$25.00 Full Day - \$40.00

Arrangements must be made 48 hours in advance with the office.

#### Late Pick Up

Child care services are provided until 6:00 pm for full day students. Half day students are to be picked up <u>no later</u> than 12:30 pm. If you are unable to pick up your child by those times, the following charges apply:

### Our Classes...

Each class has a mixture of activities, play centers, and hands-on learning time throughout the day.

**PreK-3 Class:** This class is designed for children who are three years old and will turn four during the course of the school year. Students in this class must be totally toilet trained and verbal in order to participate. Social skills are emphasized in this class.

**PreK-4 Class:** This class has a more structured learning environment. Children are encouraged to accept responsibility and taught to function independently in the classroom. The focus of this class is to prepare the children for kindergarten.

### Our Staff...

We are very blessed to have such an accomplished staff! Our lead teachers hold either Master's or Bachelor's degrees in Early Childhood education and our assistant teachers hold Associates degrees or possess extensive work experience with children. Most of our teachers and assistants have been with us for many years. In addition, our staff is also trained in CPR, BLS and First Aid.

The staff is well trained in our Christian based curriculum which is very strong in Phonics. All staff works together to provide the best wellrounded education possible for your preschooler. Teachers communicate with each other to insure that the curriculum flows in such a way that there are no learning gaps from the three year old class to the PreK-4 class and from the PreK-4 class to kindergarten.
