Important Tuition Facts

Tuition is due on the 15th of each month. If payment is not received by the 30th of the current month, children will not be permitted to return to preschool until the amount due is paid in full.

The registration fee of \$100 for the Academic Year and/or the \$40 fee for Summer Fun covers:

- All Snacks, Art materials, Curriculum materials, Writing Utensils, and Monthly subscriptions to My Big World, Science Spin, and Let's Find Out children's educational magazines.
- * Returned checks due to insufficient funds, etc. will be assessed a \$25.00 fee. Replacement payment must be made in cash or by money order only.
- * After your child has been enrolled for at least three months, you will be allowed one week vacation time for which you are not required to pay. This must be taken all in one week. A request form must be completed in advance.
 - * No money will be refunded for days missed due to illness.
 - * All holidays and in service days will be factored into the tuition.
- * A discount of 20% will be given to siblings that are attending during the same year. Siblings who are attending Life Center Academy are also entitled to a discount that will be determined through the business office. A 5% discount is given for Military/Gov't/Civil Servant, LCA Alumni, Ministers, and Missionaries.
- * On occasion, if child care is needed for additional days above what you have prepaid, the following fees apply: Half Day \$25.00 Full Day \$40.00

Arrangements must be made 48 hours in advance with the office.
