I, the Parent/Legal Guardian agree to the following terms and conditions:

- Tuition must be paid weekly. Each payment is due the Monday prior to the week attending camp. This is one week in advance payment. The payment is due on Monday prior regardless of your child's schedule. If you are not sending your child on that Monday, it is still your responsibility to pay in advance. No child will be allowed to attend until all accounts are current.
- If you are sending payment by mail, it needs to be received by our office on or before the due date. All payments received through mail after the due date will incur a late fee of \$20. All payments that are paid after the Monday prior to due date are considered late. These payments will need to include \$20 as a late fee.
- The Registration and Activities Fee and Weekly Tuition payments are non-refundable.
- We will transfer whole weeks but not individual days. We will not be held responsible for reimbursement. Please note: We will transfer whole weeks depending on the number of children attending that week. We will do our best to accommodate you but cannot guarantee we will have room in that class. We cannot be held responsible for any last minute changes in your child's schedule.
- If you would like to add days to a week that was already paid for, this can be done at the discretion of the administration and must be done at least 2 days before the day you wish to add.
- If your child attends Life Center Academy, please make sure your accounts are up to date prior to registering your child at Camp Rock.
- Returned checks will incur a \$25 bank processing fee. After one returned check, you will be required to pay cash or credit card for all tuition payments for the remainder of the camp season.
- Extra hour charges will be billed to you based on what time your child picked up. Full days are from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. If the extra hour charges are after 6 pm the extra hour charges will be \$20 per quarter hour. These charges need to be paid the day after you receive notice of extra hour fees.
- No camper is permitted on the premises before 7:00 am. Camp Rock, Fountain of Life Center, Life Center Academy or their staff members will not be responsible for your children before their scheduled times. The Parent or Guardian is required to sign your child in and out of Camp. No child, on their own, is allowed to walk into the building. They must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- All tuition payments must be made at the Camp Rock office or at the main desk of Life Center. Counselors are instructed not to accept tuition payments in the classroom. Please do not send your child with tuition checks or cash to the office. Payments need to be made by the parent/guardian.
- We will do our best to accommodate parental requests of putting certain children in the same class together but cannot guarantee that those requests will always be possible depending on our classroom ratios.
- On days that a field trip is scheduled, there are no alternate programs for your child to attend. By sending your child on these days it is implied that you approve of them attending the scheduled trip.
- Permission is hereby granted to Camp Rock for photographs and video to be taken of my child and used for promotional materials.
- Each child's legal guardian will be responsible to meet all financial obligations as outlined in this agreement. If fees are not paid in full, the legal guardian shall be liable for all costs of collection, including attorney's fees. If your account is not kept current, or your check has been returned, Camp Rock reserves the right to dismiss your child from our program until you have paid in full any outstanding balances.
- The development of Christian character and the Christian way of life as shown in the Bible will be an integral part of our program.
- All campers must adhere to the Camper Code of Conduct. The camper and parent/guardian(s) must both read and sign the Code of Conduct prior to entering camp.

Camp Rock Camper Code of Conduct – Summer Camp 2021

Here at Camp Rock we are dedicated to providing an excellent summer camp experience for our campers. To accomplish this goal, campers are expected to behave appropriately and promote a safe, fun, and healthy environment. Our goal is to promote character values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility in all aspects of our camp program. We ask that all campers and parents/guardians read this code together before arriving at camp. As a camper, I will:

RESPECT

- Be respectful, cooperative and will contribute positively to the experience of fellow campers.
- Be careful and considerate that my actions will not hurt another camper's feelings or hurt them physically, either intentionally or accidentally.
- Show respect to the camp staff, and cooperate fully with their instructions. Follow directions at all times.
- Respect the rights and beliefs of others, and treat others with courtesy and consideration.
- Respect the property of others.

PERSONAL SPACE AND PROPERTY

- Be respectful of all camp property and equipment/supplies.
- Never mark, deface or destroy camp or personal property.

BEHAVIOR

- Conduct myself responsibly. I understand that horseplay, inappropriate touching, unwelcome teasing/bullying or any unkind behavior is not allowed and will not be tolerated.
- Communicate in an appropriate manner, which means I will not use foul language, gestures, or harsh words. I will not raise my voice, or use verbal threats of any kind.
- Refrain from deliberately causing bodily harm to the campers or staff. I understand that pushing, kicking, hitting or fighting are not acceptable behavior. This behavior will not be tolerated and will be grounds for suspension/dismissal from the camp program.

SAFETY

- Campers must have a pair of closed toe shoes at camp. Campers may also bring and wear water shoes during pool time.
- Campers need to pay attention to their surroundings and use care in all activities.
- Campers will adhere to all safety rules and regulations given for each activity that he/she participates in while at camp.

GENERAL

- Campers are expected to wear appropriate clothing to camp each day. Appropriate clothing entails no extremely short, tight or low cut clothing. Girls must wear a one-piece or a modest two-piece, bathing suit with.
- Campers must inform the camp staff if they experiencing a problem with another camper or other issues. If a staff member is not informed about a problem, they cannot assist the camper or stop the problem.
- We expect all campers to have FUN, but not at the expense of others.
- Campers are encouraged to participate in activities to the best of their ability.
- Violation of the Code of Conduct can be grounds for disciplinary actions including but not limited to automatic suspension/dismissal. If a camper is suspended during camp, a partial refund will be issued for the week of camp. Refunds are not given when a camper is dismissed from the camp program.
- Weapons, look-alike weapons, or objects that may be used to threaten, intimidate, or harm others or to damage property may not be brought to camp.
- Cell phones are only permitted for emergency use only or with approval from Camp Rock staff. Cell phones and all other electronics will be collected and returned each day. If you need to get into contact with your child, please contact the Camp Rock office and the office staff will assist you in contacting your child.
