Quick Facts about LCA and LAP

How long has Life Center Academy and Little Angel Preschool been in the community?

LCA was established in 1975 and LAP was established in 1992.

Is the school affiliated with a church?

LCA & LAP are affiliated with Fountain of Life Center, which is located on the campus. Please feel free to visit us at our Burlington campus or our Trenton campus one Sunday morning!

Does LAP have a lunch program?

Yes, we provide lunch each day for an additional cost. This program is optional for families and is not required.

Are snacks school provided?

Yes, snacks are included in the cost of tuition for each child. We offer a morning snack and an afternoon snack (for full day students). Some of our snacks include bagels and cream cheese, hummus and pretzels, pancakes and applesauce, cheddar crackers, and animal crackers.

Is there a Biblical, Christian emphasis in the program?

Strong Biblical instruction is a pivotal part of our programming at LCA and LAP. We aim to introduce students to a strong moral foundation as well as allowing them the opportunity to have a relationship with Jesus. In LAP, Biblical instruction is covered through weekly Bible stories, monthly Scripture verses, and emphasis on character values throughout the year.

Does the school offer Financial Aid?

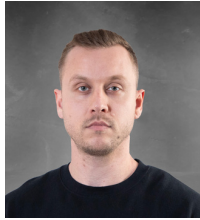
Financial Aid is available for Life Center Academy but is not currently available for Little Angel Preschool.

A Dive into our Curriculum

Like many schools, curriculum is an extremely important part of our program. We utilize Learning Without Tears in our Preschool classroom and Abeka in our PreK program. At Little Angel Preschool, we have a few goals that make our curriculum a step above the rest.

Biblical Character Development

Our Christian values are of utmost importance and are woven into each aspect of our program. As part of our Bible curriculum, we work on monthly scripture verses, weekly stories, and character development themes. Some of these themes that we focus on are thankfulness, kindness, honesty, and obedience - just to name a few!

Kindergarten Preparation

Each aspect of our curriculum points to the overall goal of Kindergarten preparedness. When Little Angel Preschool students enter Kindergarten, we want the transition to be smooth and easy. Students are prepared for Kindergarten by the structure found in our PreK classrooms and the investment by teachers into their academic work. Teachers develop lesson plans that meet students' academic needs and intentionally point towards Kindergarten standards. Our PreK students are even introduced to beginning reading skills prior to entering Kindergarten.

Inquiry Based Learning

While Kindergarten preparedness is a major goal, we recognize the importance of play based learning in a preschool setting. Teachers are encouraged to develop lessons that focus on keeping the students active and engaged through play. Whether it is social development through sharing, math development through counting legos, or pre-writing development by playing with a sand tray - students' minds will remain engaged all morning long!
